Our Security Camera Server has the capacity for additional cameras. Staff recommends adding cameras near the Readers' Services and Youth Services Desks. The Library Policy Manual requires the Board and Executive Director to consult before any security camera additions are made.

The cameras will cost \$650-750 each, depending on availability & current pricing. Each camera will need a connection boost extender because the camera will be more than 135 feet from the server in the IT office. Those extenders are generally \$150-\$200 each.

The positions of the cameras will be discussed at the Board Meeting. The Youth Services unit will be ceiling mounted. The Readers' Services unit will likely be mounted on one of the brick columns. The mounting bracket will cost approximately \$200.

Cable will cost \$135. Mike Mraz will run the cable and make the connections. This will save the library approximately \$2,000 as compared to using technicians from the security camera vendor.

The total estimated project cost will be:

2 Cameras @ \$750 each:	\$1,500
2 Connection Boost Extenders @ \$200 each:	\$ 400
1 Mounting Bracket For Readers' Services Install:	\$ 200
Cable For Connections:	\$ 135
Labor:	\$ 0
