



Instructions:

- 1. Color the mouse and his ears.
- You will need: Glue or tape Markers or Crayons Scissors

- 2. Cut out the mouse and his ears on the black lines.
- 3. Fold the mouse along the center dotted line.
- 4. Cut on the black line above the eyes.
- 5. Fold along the other dotted lines.
- 6. Slide the ears into the Cut above the eyes.
- 7. Overlap the bottom flaps. Tape or glue them together.
