



You will need:

paper

Crayons, colored pencils or markers

Scissors

Instructions:

- 1. Print page 3.
- 2. Color and cut the bus.
- 3. Cut along the dotted lines on the bus windshield.
- 4. Color and cut the characters. Make sure to cut only around the outside and not the individual characters.
- 5. Slide the characters through the slits on the windshield.
