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ALLIGATOR PUPPET

Materials: paper, popsicle sticks, crayons, glue, scissors.

- 1. Print and color your alligator.
- 2. Cut out your alligator's head, body and tail.
- 3. Fold the body strip in a zigzag like a fan.



- 4. Glue the tail and head to each end of the body.
- 5. Glue two popsicle sticks to the body.
- 6. Wiggle your alligator. SNAP!

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
