







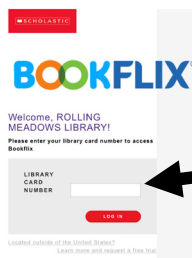
Meet Author David Shannon!

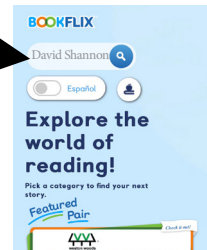

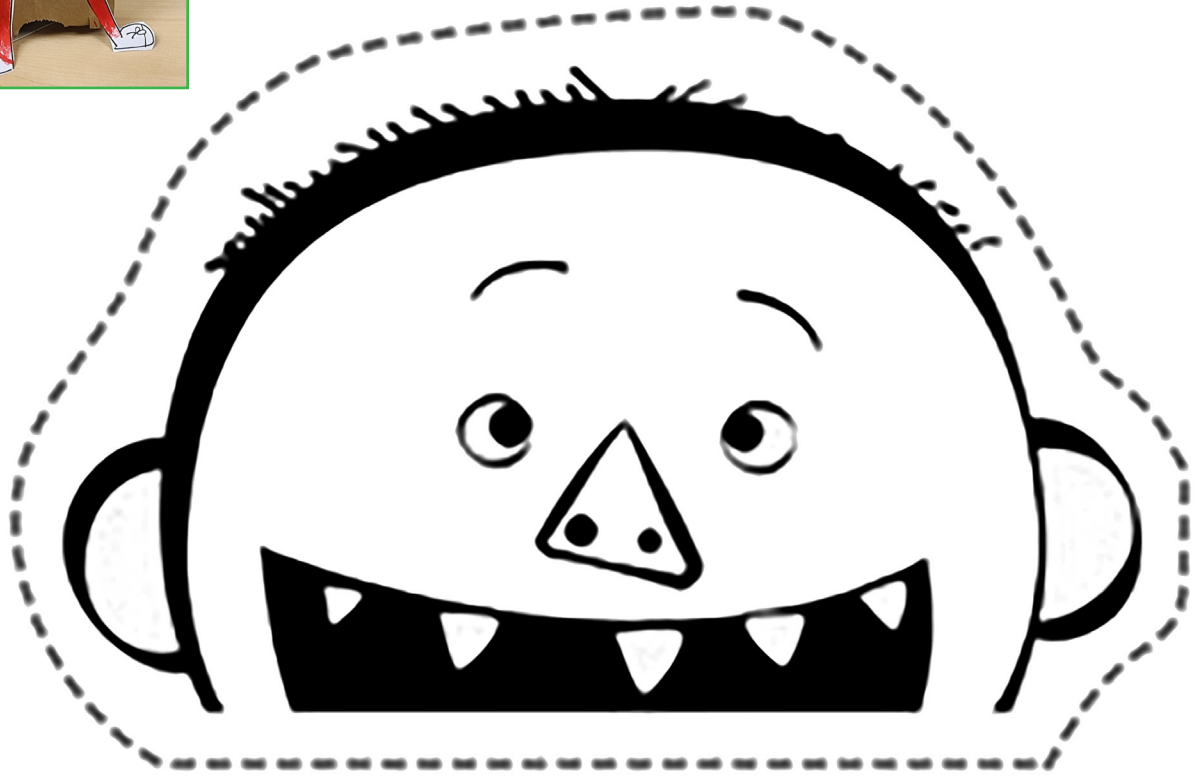
No David Paper Bag Puppet

You'll need:
a paper bag
David pattern
scissors
glue
markers or crayons

Instructions:

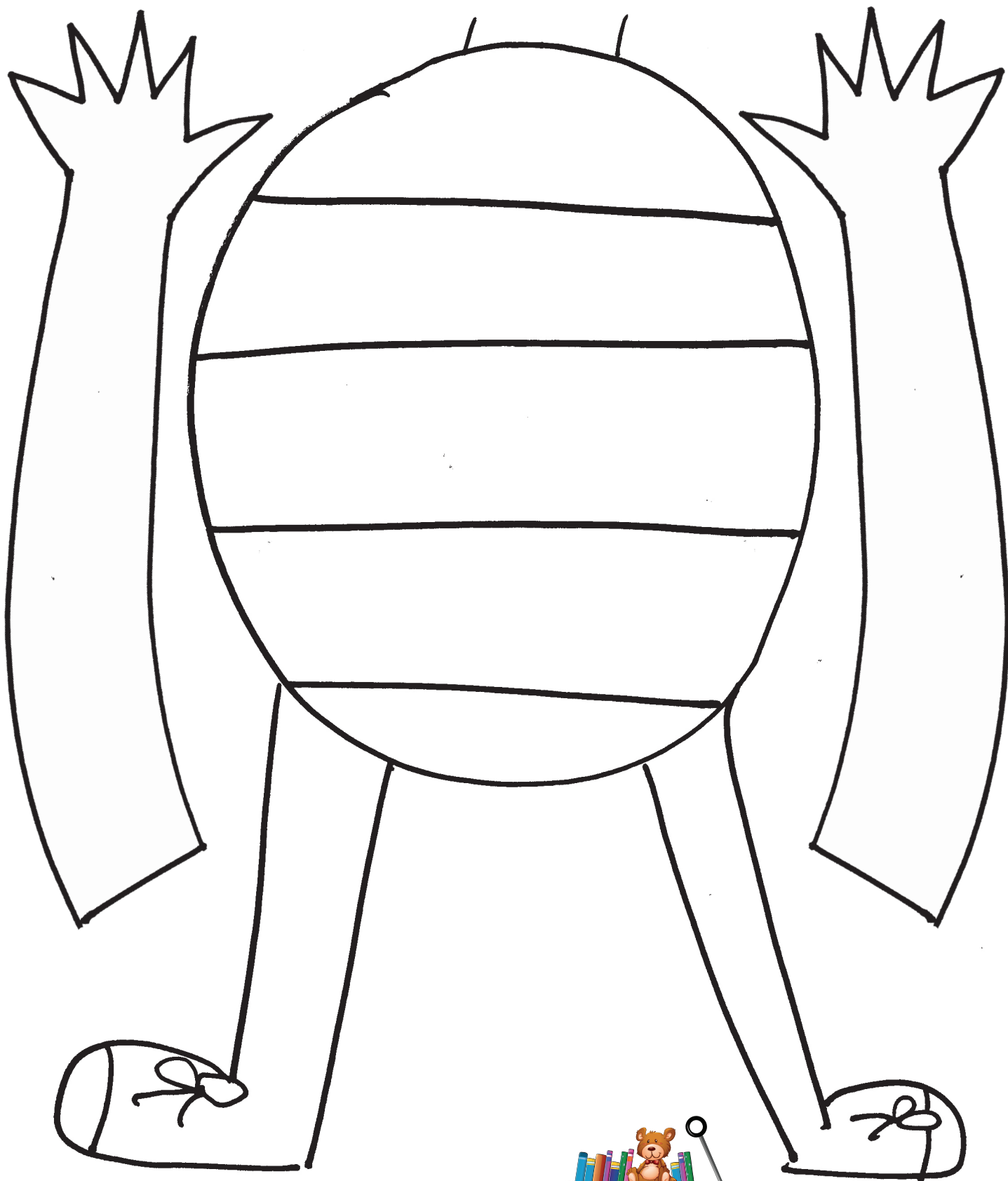
1. Print pages 2, & 3.
2. Color your David parts.
3. Cut them out.
4. Glue the head top to the flat square part of the bag.
5. Glue the mouth underneath.
6. Glue the body onto the long part of the bag.
7. Glue the arms into the side folds.

Make your David do some mischief!
