

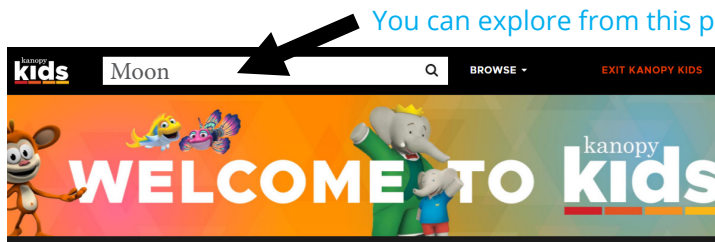


Blast Off to the Moon!

Craft: Astronaut!

You Will Need:

- 1 paper plate
- 1 paper bag or construction paper for a face
- 4 white pieces of paper for a space suit glue or tape
- scissors
- markers or crayons

1. Let an adult help with this step: Cut a face sized hole in your paper plate.
2. On a paper bag or piece of construction paper draw a face that will peek thru your space helmet. Tape or glue the face to the helmet.
3. Fold 2 sheets of paper in half the long way. Cut each in half on the fold lines. Accordion fold all 4 long pieces of paper. These are you space suit arms & legs.
4. Fold 1 piece of paper into 4 equal sections. Cut a circle out of this folded square. You will have 4 circles. These are your space gloves and boots.
5. Put together the parts. One sheet of paper is the body. Attach the head, arms, legs, gloves & boots.
6. Decorate your space suit. Fly to the moon!!
