







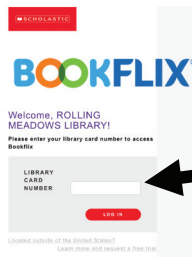

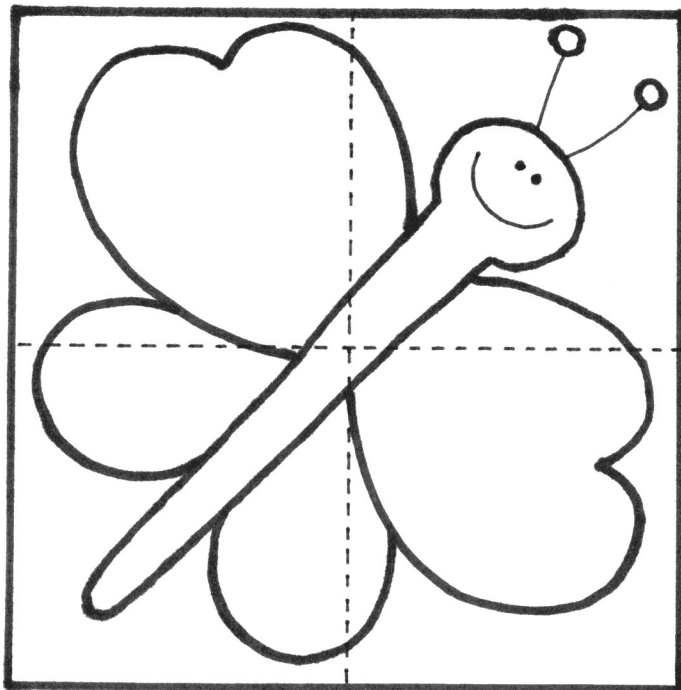
Craft: Puzzle Bugs

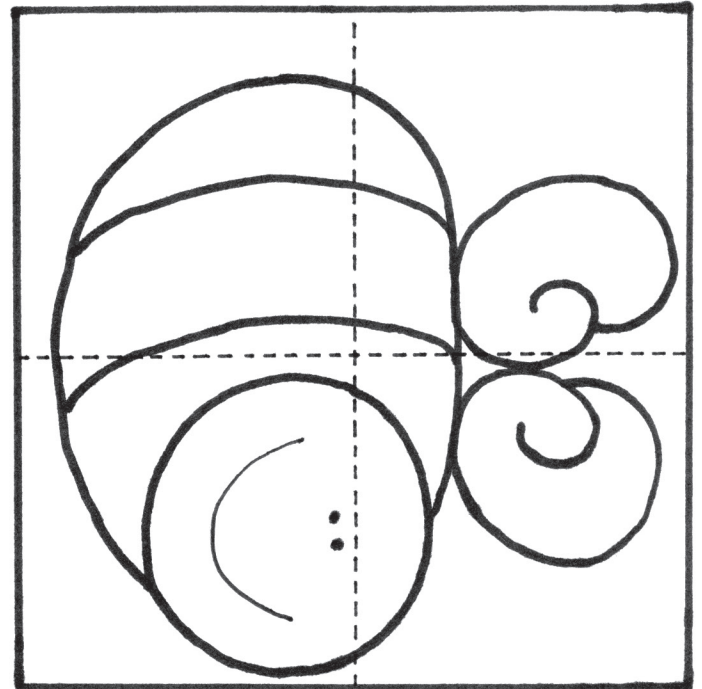
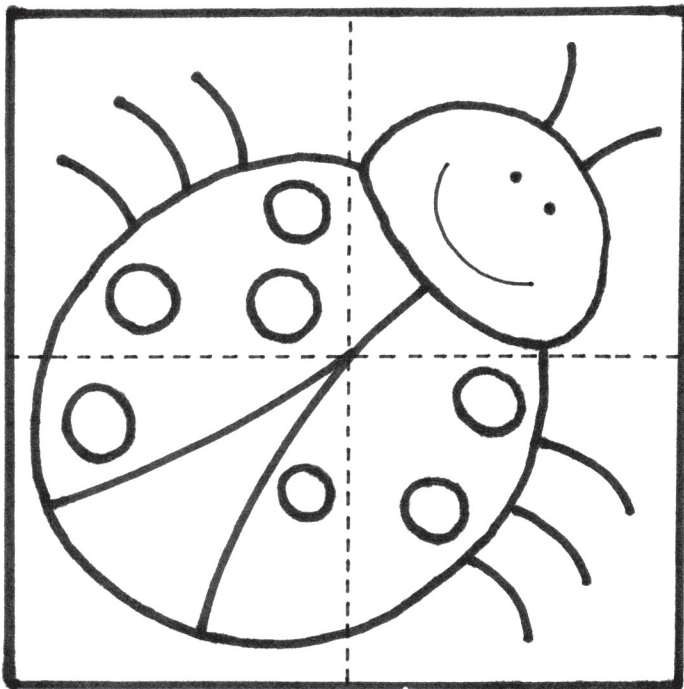
Bugs
