You will find the crafts and instructions on page 2, or come into the library and we will give you a packet with the patterns for this Storytime to Go activity.




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Make a Jumping Frog!


You will need:

a small paper plate markers or crayons scissors glue

Directions:

- 1. Print this page.
- 2. Color and cut out the parts of your frog.
- 3. Cut a little bit of the top of the plate, see image.
- 4. Color the plate.
- 5. Glue the eyes, mouth, tongue and legs to the plate.
