You will find the craft and instructions on pages 2 & 3. Or, come to the library and we will give you a packet of this Storytime to Go activity including the printed craft.



Wolf Hat

You'll need: crayons, color pencils or markers Scissors glue or tape

Instructions:

1. Print pages 2 & 3. Color and cut wolfs eyes, snout and the ears attached to headband. 2. Fold the dotted lines on the snout and glue it to the headband. 3. Glue the eyes onto the face. 4. Cut out another piece of paper to make the headband big enough for you, adjust it to fit your head and glue it or tape it together. Now you are ready to huff and Puff! Have fun!
