## **SNOWY OWL CRAFT**

#### You'll Need:

two small dessert-size paper plates white paper (construction paper is best) markers or crayons glue and Scissors



### **Instructions:**

- 1. Start by cutting one of the paper plates in half for the wings
- 2. Tear the withe paper into pieces of different sizes. These will be the feathers.
- 3. Glue the pieces of paper to the two half plates.
- 4. Glue the wings underneath the other paper plate
- 5. Draw the eyes and beak on the owl. See the picture for a reference.
