# Stories for Winter Nights

## DIY Flashlight Projector

### You'll need:

4 or more cardboard tubes (toilet paper or paper towel)

Plastic wrap or ziplock bags

foamy stickers or make your own drawings

a small flashlight

rubber bands

glue

### Instructions:

Cut 4 pieces of plastic wrap or from a ziplock bag and put each piece over one end of the paper tube. Hold it in place with a rubber band. Glue one of the stickers or drawings in the middle of the plastic wrap that you put over the tube end. Use the flashlight to shine light through the tube and the shape of the sticker or drawing will be projected onto the wall.
