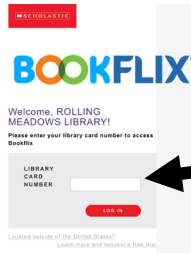

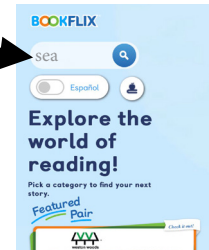

You can explore from this page. Type *sea* in the Search Box and you'll find *Sea Bones*.

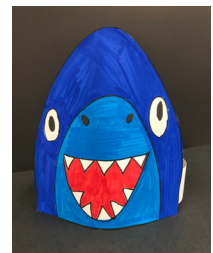
