



Pig the Pug Paper Bag Puppet

You'll need: a lunch bag scissors glue

Instructions: 1. Print this page. 2. Cut out the ears, eyes, snout and tail. Cut on the white dotted lines of the tail. 3. Glue ears, eyes and snout onto the rectangular flat part at the top of the paper bag. 4. Glue the center of the tail onto the back side of the bag. Let the glue dry. Try to make your Pig behave!
