



Good news on the West Wing Construction Project:

WE'RE STARTING EARLY!

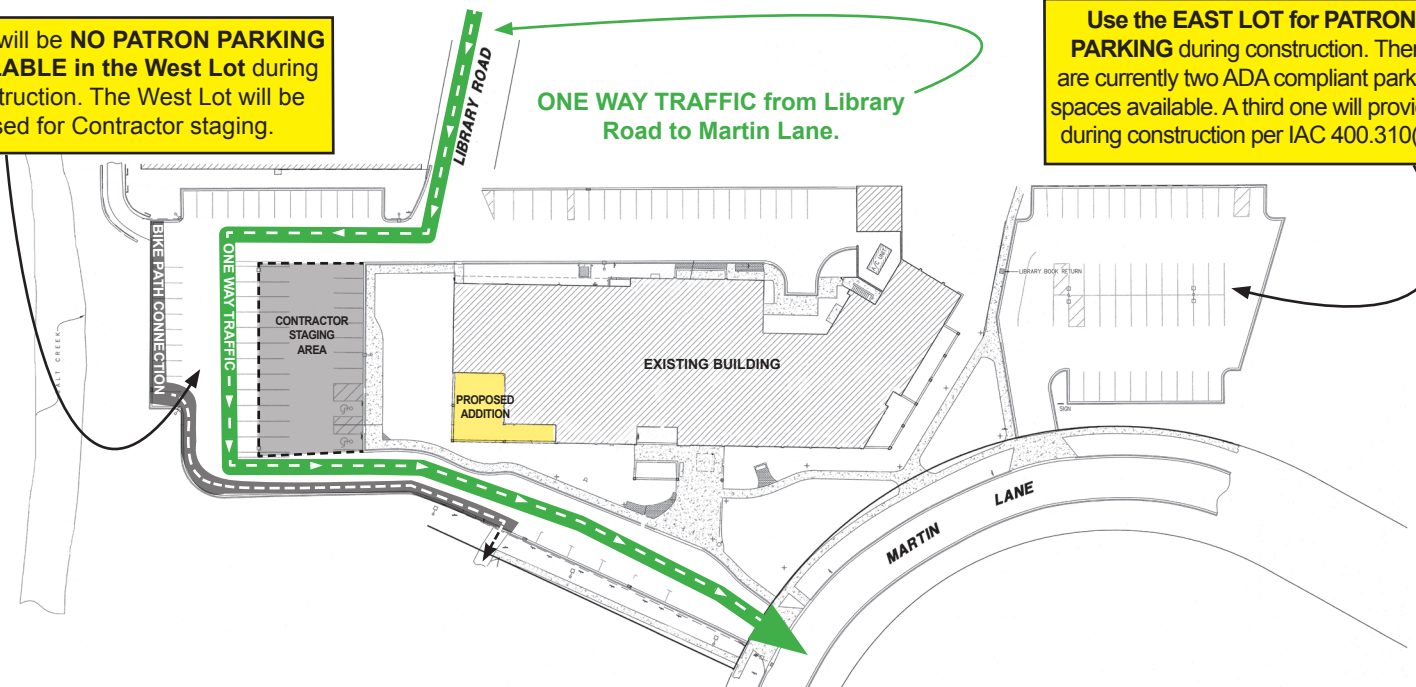
In fact, we will start on March 30 rather than early May. The early start offers the possibility of an early finish. We hope to have the project completed in July. Here are some of the changes you will see once we start construction:

- There will be no patron parking in the West Parking Lot (the side towards Salt Creek). All patron parking will be in the East Lot.
- Traffic through our West Parking Lot will be one-way from Library Road to Martin Lane. There will be no entry from Martin Lane to the entrance of the library or the West Parking Lot.

There will be **NO PATRON PARKING AVAILABLE** in the West Lot during construction. The West Lot will be used for Contractor staging.

Use the **EAST LOT for PATRON PARKING** during construction. There are currently two ADA compliant parking spaces available. A third one will be provided during construction per IAC 400.310(c).

ONE WAY TRAFFIC from Library Road to Martin Lane.



- The West Wing will be closed to patrons. If you need a non-fiction book, ask at the Readers' Services Desk and a librarian will retrieve it for you.
- The Reference Desk and up to 15 Internet computers will be moved to the East Wing near the Reader's Services Desk. If you need a non-fiction book, ask at the Readers' Services Desk and a librarian will retrieve it for you from the West Wing.
- Copier machines and additional seating will also be moved to the East Wing.
- The Youth Services Department will remain fully open and operational throughout the project. The upper floor of the library will also remain open so that programs and meetings can continue.

We know there will be some disruption for the next three to four months, but hope you will join us in July as we open the doors to a welcoming new space for our library and community!
